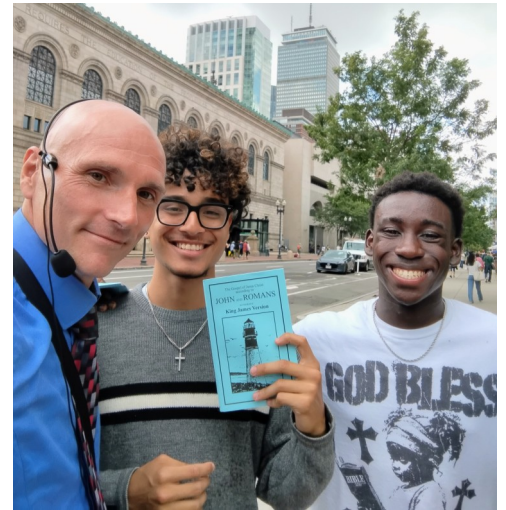

# MORE FRUIT FROM D.R. CONGO

We at Hope Tract Ministry are very excited at what God is doing in the Democratic Republic of Congo through Umba wa Bondo Kazadi. Here are some excerpts from his latest report.



“Mulongo is a rural village where the King James Bible was translated into the Kiluba language in 1947. Unfortunately the Christian faith has decreased on western side of Molongo some years ago. It became the headquarters of Mayimayi militia who practiced cannibalism for their witchcraft during various civilian wars. This darkest movement extended up to Konga. The Lord has given us a burning desire to reach these peoples. In this journey 27 peoples have come to Christ.”

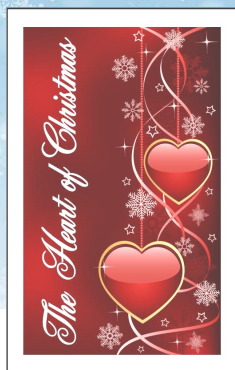
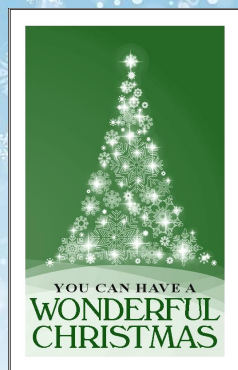
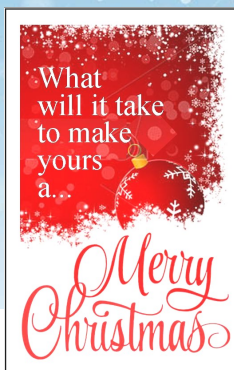
What a blessing it was to listen to his message! Pray for Andrew as he begins his new life in Christ
