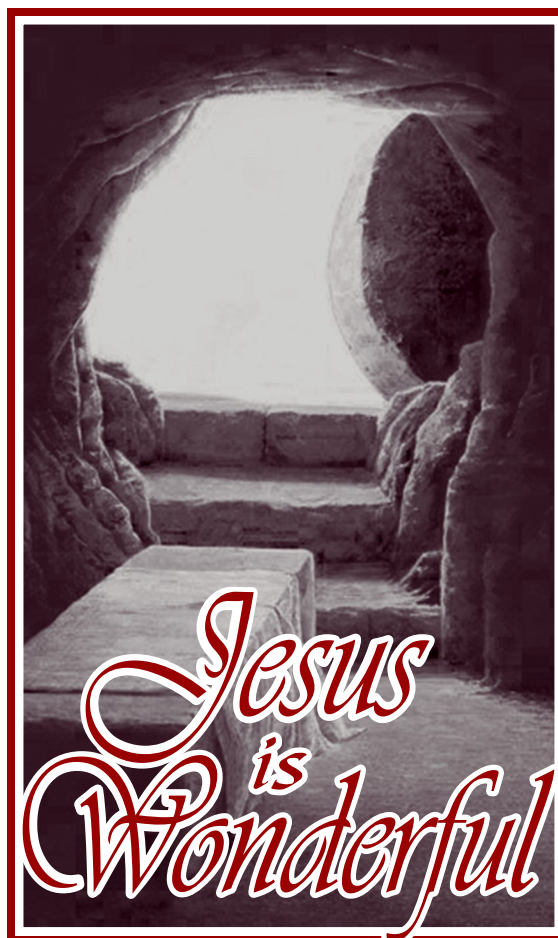

The Bible tells us of Someone Who is absolutely Wonderful. He is not some modern day hero, sports figure, or politician, but I speak of One who is truly wonderful in every way. He is described this way in the Bible (the Word of God). *“For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.”* (Isaiah 9:6)
