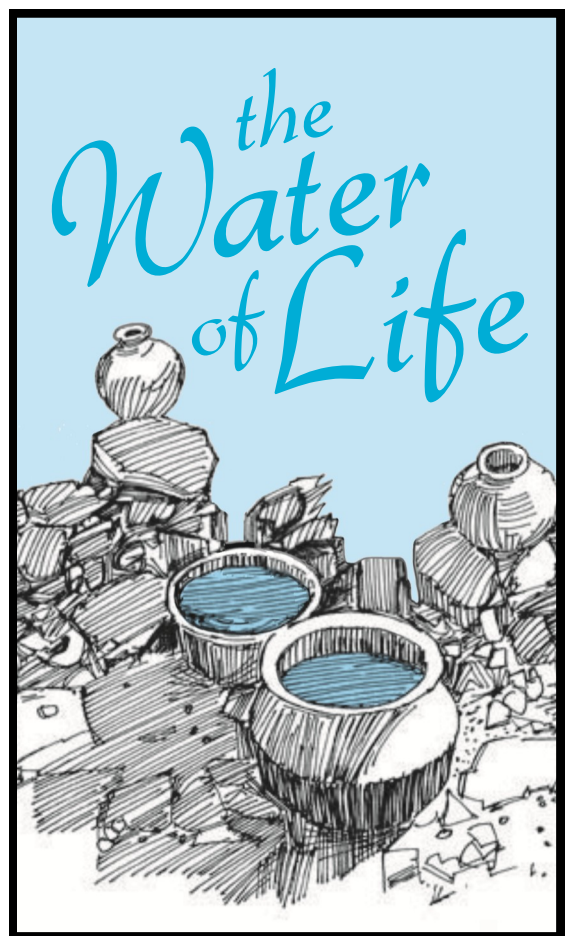

Tales of a fountain that supposedly heals the body of anyone who drinks or bathes in its waters have been recounted throughout the world for thousands of years. While no such water exists, there is water that will give one spiritual life. The existence of the water of life is first mentioned in the Bible by Jesus.

In John 4:13-14 Jesus met a woman of Samaria at Jacob's well. He told her that the water in that well would only satisfy her for a short time. *"Jesus...said unto her, Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again: But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life."*

In verses 16 through 18, Jesus not only demonstrates His supernatural knowledge but also points out her need for this water by reminding her of the sin in her life. *"Jesus saith unto her, Go, call thy husband, and come hither. The woman answered and said, I have no husband. Jesus said unto her, Thou hast well said, I have no husband: For thou hast had five husbands; and he whom thou now hast is not thy husband: in that saidst thou truly."*

This woman received that water of life and ran home to tell everyone what had happened. How did she get the water? The same way you and I can receive it. She believed that Jesus was who He said He was - the Messiah. *"The woman saith unto him, I know that Messiah cometh, which is called Christ: when he is come, he will tell us all things. Jesus saith*

unto her, I that speak unto thee am he...The woman then left her waterpot, and went her way into the city, and saith to the men, Come, see a man, which told me all things that ever I did: is not this the Christ?" John 4:25,26,28,29 Jesus is the Messiah, the Christ, Son of the living God. He is God in human flesh who came to die on a cross for the sins of the world.

Jesus tells us in John 7:37-39 that this water of which He has been speaking is the Holy Spirit. *"...Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive..."*

This water cannot be bought nor earned but is a gift. Jesus said in Revelation 21:6 *"...I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely."* God invites all who are willing to come and receive this water that He offers. *"And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely."* Revelation 22:17

Those who receive it will not only escape the damnation of Hell but will also spend eternity in Heaven with Jesus. The Bible tells us that Heaven has a river filled with the water of life. *"And he shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God..."* Revelation 22:1
