## LOOKING BACK AT 2025

We had a blessed Christmas and want to thank all of you who sent Christmas gifts and hope yours was a blessing as well. God is good all the time, but it is encouraging to look back and be reminded of some of that goodness toward us and Hope Tract Ministry in 2025. One of the things I can't help but think about is how God spared my wife Kim and me from serious injury on September 8 when a man traveling at a high rate of speed ran a red light and plowed into the front of our car. The Lord saved a boy in New Jersey and two men in New York through our tracts. We shipped thousands of tracts to our friend Umba wa Bondo Kazadi in the Democratic Republic of Congo and after working in at least 6 villages that we know of, he reported that 447 people were saved through those tracts and Bibles this past year! Of these, 187 were children, 64 were teens and 96 were adults. He translated one of our Christmas tracts “You Can Have a Wonderful Christmas” into the Kiluba language. We look forward to what God will do in this coming year and believe that Christ could return at any time. May we be found faithful! Thank you all for your prayers and financial support.
