NEW CHRISTMAS TRACTS WERE WELCOMED



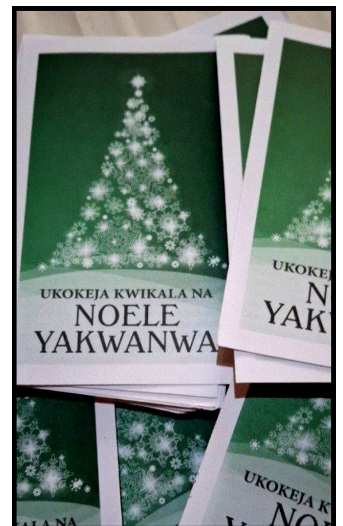
Umба wa Bondi Kazadi

One of our Christmas tract was translated into Kiluba by Bro. Umба last year and we shipped him the first batch to distribute in the Congo. Bro. Umба wrote: *“We were so happy when I came back from outreach in villages, to find the arrival of new tracts in Kiluba ‘You Can Have A Wonderful Christmas.’ ”*

He sent this update on his missionary activities in Konga and Watupembe villages:

“Given the ongoing war in the northeast, which is also spreading southeast, there are numerous military checkpoints inspecting all packages and luggage.

In any case, some Bibles and tracts were taken. While trying to take some photos I was unfortunately struck hard on the cheek.”



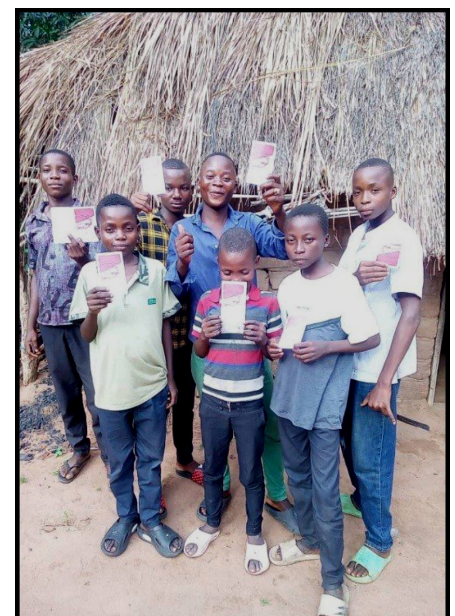
KONGA VILLAGE

“When we arrived in Konga village, the Lord gave us opportunity to share the Gospel through free distributions of Hope Tracts in various places in Konga and door to door. We were so glad to meet (left) this man named Jackson Ngoy and Clementine and Jacqueline Sungu. They met Christ by reading the tract ‘Which Way.’ Now they are attending our Bible class in Konga. They are so poor that we tried to provide them some second-hand clothes and sandals.”

“In Konga Villkage we were one day invited to speak to poorest pupils in Primary School where we decided to share with them the Gospel message. The Hope Tracts touched seven teens (right) and they gave their lives to Jesus Christ as their personal Saviour. The principal was so happy at how some of these children responded to the Gospel. But it is so sad when you see their clothes and many of them don’t have shoes or sandals. We try to collect but it isn’t enough to cover the needs in these villages.”



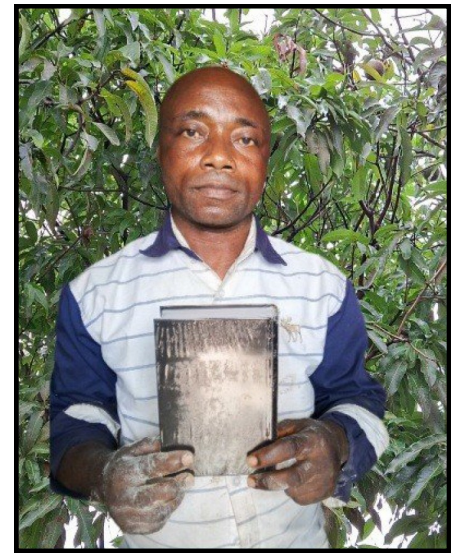
